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2 Every student in grades K-8 will participate in a program of physical education.<sup>1</sup> Students in  
3 grades 9-12 must receive 0.5 credits in Physical Education to meet graduation requirements.  
4 State approved activities may be substituted to meet this requirement.<sup>2</sup>

6 A coordinated physical education program shall be developed for K-8 with supervision  
7 appropriate for each level. Physical education curricula will be appropriate to the physical  
8 condition, age, acquired skills, and previous instruction of the participating students.
