**Summer School & Non-Traditional Instruction**

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1. A summer high school program may be organized and operated under the control and management of the Board of Education in compliance with rules and regulations prescribed by the State and the local Board.<sup>1</sup>
  2. For grades 1-8, a summer school shall be established only for removing deficiencies of pupils and for providing enrichment.
  3. Course credits may be earned in summer school.
  4. Course credit may be earned in a traditional classroom setting or through non-traditional avenues such as A+ Learning Systems and/or enrichment and remediation courses on the internet.
  5. All course credits received through non-traditional avenues must have prior approval of the Director of Schools.
  6. Attendance laws apply to students participating in any remedial instruction that is required by the student's school, including summer programs and after-school instruction. The decision to require attendance shall be made by the principal who shall consider the transportation available to the student (Public Chapter 219).
  7. In addition to the rules above, *Tennessee Rules, Regulations, and Minimum Standards* shall be followed in conducting summer schools, credit recovery programs, or other supplemental resources.
