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2 Students in the 10th, 11th, or 12th grades who are in good standing may earn high school credit by
3 enrolling in college level courses which are conducted at times other than the regular school day
4 at an institution of higher education.¹ Written approval by the principal shall be required before
5 enrollment, and an agreement from the parent/guardian must be signed and on file at the school.

- 7 1. To be eligible, students must meet the participating institution's admissions criteria.
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- 9 2. Students must be in good standing, maintaining at least a 3.0 grade point average and
10 earning the recommendation of the teacher and/or principal.

- 12 3. Students may participate in college level courses conducted during the school day on the
13 high school campus in accordance with requirements stated in the state regulations.

- 15 4. Students may be approved by the school principal to enroll in a college course during the
16 school day on the college campus, provided the student's schedule can be arranged to
17 make this option possible.

20 The Board shall not be responsible for transportation to and from the college or for payment of
21 tuition, fees, or supplies.
