2 The Board adopts this Code of Ethics as recommended by the Tennessee School Boards Association as a  
3 guide to its members as they provide educational leadership for the youth of our state. The Board further  
4 agrees that ethical issues regarding the Board or its members may be referred to the TSBA Advisory  
5 Ethics Commission.

## 7 **ARTICLE I. MY RELATIONS TO THE CHILDREN**

8

9 Section 1. I will at all times think in terms of "children first," always determining other important  
10 things according to how they affect education and training of children.

11

12 Section 2. I will seek to provide equal educational opportunities for all children regardless of ability,  
13 race, color, sex, creed or location of residence.

## 15 **ARTICLE II. MY RELATIONS TO MY COMMUNITY**

16

17 Section 1. I will endeavor to appraise fairly both the present and future educational needs of the  
18 community and to support improvements as finances permit.

20 Section 2. I will represent at all times the entire school community and refuse to represent special  
21 interests or partisan politics.

23 Section 3. I will endeavor to keep the community informed about the progress and needs of the  
24 schools.

## 26 **ARTICLE III. MY RELATIONS TO TEACHERS AND PERSONNEL**

28 Section 1. I will support the employment of those persons best qualified to serve as employees and  
29 insist on a regular and impartial evaluation of all staff.

31 Section 2. I will support and protect personnel in performance of their duties.

32

33 Section 3. I will not criticize employees publicly but will make such criticism to the Superintendent  
34 for investigation and action if necessary.

## 36 **ARTICLE IV. MY RELATIONS WITH OTHER BOARD MEMBERS**

38 Section 1. I will recognize that authority rests only with the Board in official meetings and that the  
39 individual member has no legal status outside of such meetings.

41 Section 2. I will refuse to make promises as to how I will vote on a matter which should properly  
42 come before the Board as a whole.

44 Section 3. I will make decisions only after full discussion of matters at a board meeting.

45

46 Section 4. I will respect the opinion of other members and will accept the principle of "majority  
47 rule."

1 **ARTICLE V. MY RELATIONS WITH THE SUPERINTENDENT**

2  
3 Section 1. I will support full administrative authority as well as responsibility for the Superintendent  
4 to properly discharge all professional duties.

5  
6 Section 2. I will support Superintendent accountability for working and requiring staff to work  
7 within the framework of policies set up by the Board.

8  
9 Section 3. I will refer all complaints and concerns to the Superintendent.

11 **ARTICLE VI. MY RELATIONS TO MYSELF**

12  
13 Section 1. I will inform myself about my duties and responsibilities and current educational issues  
14 by individual study and through participation in programs providing needed information,  
15 such as those sponsored by my state and national school boards associations.

17 Section 2. I will avoid being placed in a position of conflict of interest, and will refrain from using  
18 my board position for personal or partisan gain.
