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3 The rules contained in the current edition of *Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised*, shall govern the
4 Board in all cases to which they are applicable, except as otherwise provided by any statutes¹ applicable
5 to the Board, or by policies of this Board including the following exceptions:

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7 **VOTING METHOD**

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9 When a formal vote is taken on any question brought before the Board, the decision shall be made on the
10 basis of a majority of the membership of the Board.²

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12 Roll call votes will be used at the discretion of the chairman or upon the request of any board member.
13 Each member's vote shall be recorded in the minutes on a roll call vote. Upon request, any member's
14 individual vote may be recorded in the minutes. No secret votes shall be used.³

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16 **CHAIRMAN'S PARTICIPATION**

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18 The person chairing a meeting may participate in discussion, make motions, and vote on all issues as any
19 other member without relinquishing the chair.⁴

21 **SUSPENSION OF RULES**

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23 Rules of order may be suspended by a two-thirds vote at any regular or special meeting.
