2 A teacher who is absent from assigned duties as a result of personal injury caused by physical
3 assault or other violent criminal acts committed in the course of the teacher's employment
4 activities shall receive workers' compensation or comparable benefits without loss of
5 accumulated or granted sick, personal, or professional leave.¹

6
7 A signed statement listing the cause of the absence shall be provided by the employee on forms
8 furnished by the director of schools and shall promptly be given to the immediate supervisor in
9 support of all claims. A certificate from the physician on forms furnished by the director of
10 schools may also be required to verify the extent of the injury.²
